### MEETING OF THE CLALLAM COUNTY LAW LIBRARY BOARD

Guest Erin Shield, North Olympic Library System (NOLS) and Todd Mielke, County Administrator, were also in attendance.

### BUSINESS ITEMS

- **Law Library launch update**

Administrator Mielke reminded folks that there were some issues encountered when launching the program. He noted this was not an issue with NOLS but with the LexisNexis Program terms and condition page.

Erin Shield, NOLS, updated that the program is now live to the public in the Port Angeles library branch. There is one minor printing issue, but they do have a workaround so the public can use the system. NOLS is working on some furniture moves in the Forks Branch and once that project is completed, they will launch the Forks library branch location. Shield commented on personal information and third party acknowledge information with the system. NOLS has not issued a press release yet but plans to do so soon. They also plan to issue in their NOLS newsletter once the Forks library branch is running.
