PLANNING DISCUSSION WITH DISTRICTING MASTER(S)


- Commissioner Marrs noted that new redistricting lines will take effect at the 2012 County election

- Public meeting requirements were discussed. Consensus is to schedule a centrally located informational/public input meeting on April 14 at 2:30 p.m. in the Clallam County Commissioners' Meeting Room, Port Angeles. Chairman Marrs will work with Trish Holden to develop a press release.
- Commission discussed requirement for three additional meetings (one in each District) once informational meeting is complete and Districting Master(s) provides proposed final districting boundaries. Dates to be scheduled later.
- Gene Unger provided the attached information, which will be presented at the meeting on April 14 including base census data for 2000 and 2010 and maps.






