Clallam County Fair Royalty is a program organized to promote, and advertise the county fair, along with helping to make a difference in our community. Clallam County Fair Royalty is eligible for a scholarship upon high school graduation. Our royalty will have the opportunity to meet people and make new friends in and out of Clallam County by promoting the fair in parades, civic events, and participating in the **CLALLAM COUNTY FAIR.**

The **CLALLAM COUNTY FAIR ROYALTY** program is open to high school students **residing and living in Clallam County.** Candidates must be enrolled in a high school/home school/private program with the same Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, and Senior qualifications, Ages 14-18 and a GPA of 2.0 or better is required. The GPA of 2.0 needs to be met throughout candidacy. A candidate may not be crowned if they have a failing grade in any subject or be truant in any class. A January coronation is planned. **The fair royalty court is selected through a candidacy process which includes training meetings, speaking appearances and engagement in community service. Selection is a point system based on personality, poise, appearance, presentation, responsibility, attendance, punctuality, initiative, and seeking monetary donations. Points are not disclosed. Judging before and at coronation all contribute to court selection. It is the Royalty Committee's decision to determine the size of the court each year.**

Please look at **EVENT DATE SHEET** carefully and determine if you can attend **ALL** mandatory dates listed. The new court **MUST** be able to attend all royalty dates listed on the Event Date Sheet. After court selection, not adhering to mandatory dates **WILL** affect the outcome of the scholarship. It is **MANDATORY** for **CURRENT** royalty to attend the next year's coronation to receive the scholarship. Royalty court will serve for one year, from coronation to coronation.

**CLALLAM COUNTY FAIR ROYALTY IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION 61-1587782**

**PLEASE READ AND SIGN THE FOLLOWING CONTRACT. KEEP CONTRACT.**

If one has been crowned queen, they are retired. The royalty court will serve from one year (coronation to coronation) to receive scholarship.

1. Candidate/Court agrees not to enter any other beauty, popularity, or like contest, outside of the local school or community during that one-year term.
2. Candidate must be enrolled in a high school/home school/private school, (9-12 grades ages 14-18. Because Fair Royalty provides a scholarship, candidate must have a GPA of 2.0 or better upon application and must maintain this GPA until graduation with no failing classes. Candidates must have a commutative school attendance record of 90%. Candidate will abide by the Washington State Truancy Law (the "Becca Bill") regarding absence during any school year. Candidate/court that is continually truant or have unexcused attendance, may be put on temporary suspension, or may be disqualified from continuing to be a part of the royalty court, thus losing all awards, scholarships, and attire furnished by the Royalty Committee.
3. Alcohol consumption, smoking, vaping, use of non-prescription drugs, recreational drugs or otherwise immoral and illegal conduct by candidate or court, will result in automatic and immediate disqualification. Candidate/court cannot be involved or have been charged with illegal activities. Any or all listed can be subject to immediate dismissal and forfeiture of scholarship.
4. Candidate/court and families will always maintain consideration and good conduct to Royalty Committee, Judges, Fair Board, and anybody associated with the Clallam County Fair. This must always be maintained. The candidate/court must be of good character, shall not have been or currently married, pregnant or have a child prior to or while representing fair royalty in the court of the one year. Candidate/court member cannot co-habitat with an intimate partner. Candidate and court are to refrain from public displays of affection or sexual activities at all events or activities court related or not. This is from the time of orientation and if court member, until next year's coronation which is program year. Obscene and discriminatory language, and insubordination will not be tolerated. The royalty committee may dismiss any candidate/court member if, in its opinion, the members conduct is such that dismissal would be in the best interest of the Clallam County Fair Royalty and/or the member.
5. The candidate/court will arrive promptly and on time, at all functions. Two or more unexcused tardies or missed events may result in suspension from any function and/or dismissal from the royalty court altogether and loss of scholarship funds.
6. There will be no tattooing or body piercing as candidate or court member. Visible piercings such as brows, nose, lips, tongue, etc. will have to be removed. Normal ear piercing is acceptable. Visible tattoos will need to be covered. Men cannot have facial piercing including earring and/or gauges. Please do not color your hair after orientation.
7. Cell phones cannot be used during workdays or scheduled events unless permission has been given by the Royalty Committee. Please ask your family and friends not to call you or text you during your time involved.
8. Royalty duties are important. You will be expected to do your best to be available and on time for scheduled events and visits. If employed, upon selection to the court, you must notify your employer of the activity demands that will be expected of you. If you must miss an event, you must notify the Royalty Committee immediately.

9. **FACEBOOK/SOCIAL MEDIA.** You are expected to treat Facebook AND ALL SOCIAL MEDIA as you would your personal behavior. No profane, obscene, and discriminatory language, no bullying, no sexual pictures, no firearm posting, no alcoholic beverages, no smoking or vaping, shall appear in any posting or in any photos. **You will maintain the highest level of integrity and poise and will avoid even the slightest implication of inappropriate behavior.**  
You will be asked to "friend" a member of the royalty committee with Facebook. The committee will examine pages periodically and subject to removal.
10. Candidates/courts will need to check email, voicemail, text messages regularly as this is how the committee will be providing information, and you will need to respond promptly. Messages will not be posted on Facebook or social media.
11. Chaperon's will be furnished by the royalty committee. Royalty is to remain under the chaperon's supervision, traveling to, during and returning from all events. Candidate/court will provide their own transportation to and from all designated meeting places. Court members will ride with chaperone(s) to activities.
12. One requiring special needs will furnish their own helpers and/or equipment at the applicant's expense. Candidate/court will be responsible for medical coverage.
13. No reproduction of any photograph taken by any professional photographer unless they have written authorization/permission by said photographer. If pictures are posted, they must give credit to professional photographers.
14. Parents are welcome to attend the events listed; HOWEVER, all will be respectful to royalty committee for decisions made, fair manager and those involved with fair royalty. Rules laid down for candidate and court ALSO APPLY to parents/family. Parents/family, friends are responsible for their own transportation to any event. The royalty committee will only pay for royalty court at events. Parents/family, friends may be asked to leave any event if the royalty committee deems so.
15. If a court member, it is the family's responsibility to provide housing arrangements during the fair which will include where court members stay each night, how court members get to the fair each morning and how court members get home each night. The committee provides lunch, and snacks during the fair.
16. The royalty committee will set and determine clothing guidelines for ALL events. If one arrives at an event dressed inappropriately, one will be sent home, and the event will be considered unexcused. Wear neat, clean, and appropriate attire, including shoes, boots, or appropriate footwear always. Clothing cannot be cut low or have inappropriate sayings on them. No PJ bottoms and no shorts can be worn to any workday or any event or while traveling to and from any event. For coronation, a gown will need to be purchased. The gown cannot be low cut either in front or back, cannot have slits, and must have straps. NO cleavage. A picture of the gown, front and back taken while on candidate, will be sent and will need committee approval. Only the gown approved by the committee can be worn at coronations. NO SUBSTITUTIONS. If you arrive at a coronation with a different, you will be asked to go home and get the one that was approved. After royalty clothes are chosen and purchased. Those clothing items will be the only allowed clothing items to wear. Parents will be respectful of decisions made by the royalty committee. The committee provides hats, tiara, sash, shirts, pants, belt and boots. NO other accessories or other clothing can be purchased by parent/other person for royalty to wear. If items are lost or not maintained, it will be the financial responsibility of the court member to replace them.

From time of orientation to coronation, the candidate will accumulate points to determine court. Candidates will be judged at ALL events. A typical court consists of three court members, but the royalty committee maintains the right to determine the size of the court in any given year. **THE FIRST SATURDAY OF OCTOBER IS DEADLINE/ORIENTATION AT THE EXPO Building on the fairgrounds. 1:00 PM.** Program will be discussed in full along with mandatory requirements and events. Parent/guardian or responsible adult must be accompanying candidate. Please bring the completed royalty application along with your current transcripts.

**An October fundraiser will be discussed at orientation. JUDGED EVENT. On January 10 a guest will be helping us with stage presentation for coronation. This will be a judged event.**

## ROYALTY CONTRACT

**Court Members are expected to always conduct themselves befitting Fair Royalty. Royalty will be well groomed, gracious, and courteous, and they will appear as Royalty only at scheduled events and only with their chaperone.**

### **PARENT(S)/GUARDIAN(S) AND CANDIDATE**

(I) (WE) have read, understand, and agree to abide by **ALL** the Rules for Clallam County Fair Royalty. It is agreed that the Candidate has a **2.0 GPA** or better at the time of orientation meeting and will maintain this until high school graduation. Transcripts will be required before scholarship.

(I) (WE) have read and understand that all workdays and events are mandatory and if candidate/court member does not attend these mandatory dates and ALL FOUR days of Fair short of illness, death in family, or some unforeseen incident, may result in an immediate dismissal or probation, and forfeiture of any scholarship funds, awards and attire furnished by the Royalty Committee.

(I) (WE) - In the event I should be chosen as one of the Clallam County Fair Royalty courts, I understand and agree that I will be available through my royalty year (coronation to coronation) to participate in and to fulfill obligations as designated by the Royalty Committee.

(I) (WE) have read and understand that the Royalty Committee and other organization members, may dismiss any Candidate/court member from serving as Royalty if, in its opinion, the Candidate/court member is such that dismissal would be in the best interest of the Clallam County Fair/Royalty and/or the Candidate.

If any of the conditions herein should be violated by the Candidate/court member, the Royalty Committee will notify Candidate/court member of the alleged violation and give Candidate/court member an opportunity to appear before selected members of the Royalty Committee, Fair Manager and organization members and respond to any alleged violations. The Royalty Committee, Fair Manager and or other appointed members representing the Clallam County Fair Royalty may dismiss or suspend any Candidate/court member from serving as royalty at any function, if in the board's opinions conduct and behavior is such that dismissal would be in the best interest of the Clallam County Fair and Fair Royalty and the community. Such violations that occur within the term and are recognized within six (6) months after that term, may result in the forfeiture of scholarships, awards and attire furnished by the Royalty Committee. In the event of dismissal, all clothes and accessories purchased by the Royalty Committee must be returned to the Royalty Committee within seven (7) days of the written request. This may also include any cash awards or scholarship given.

There is a two-year period to ask for and receive scholarships which starts from the time of high school graduation or high school equivalent. After two years the scholarship will not be awarded.

**General Rules:**

In order to receive a Clallam County Fair Royalty scholarship, Candidates must have a **2.0 GPA** or better upon application at orientation. Candidates must be enrolled in an accredited high school program, home school or private school. From the time of Candidates becoming actual royalty court, the **2.0 GPA** must be maintained for the length of time student is in school. There is a waiting time of one-year (coronation to coronation) to be able to receive scholarship, and one must have graduated from high school meeting the criteria of Washington State for high school seniors to receive scholarship. If a court member does not attend next year's coronation, the scholarship will automatically be withdrawn. Only ACCREDITED universities, community colleges, tech schools, are eligible for royalty scholarships. Court members will give the Royalty Committee name of the school and address where the scholarship is going along with student ID number. Checks are mailed directly to school and no check will be given to court members or family members.

If a royalty contract is not honored, court members will forfeit scholarships and will be asked to return all and any royalty clothes or items that royalty committee has given them.
