How to Vote




Use a **dark colored pen** to completely fill in the oval to the left of your choice.

**Clallam County Hospital District No. 1
Proposition No. 1
Levy Lid Lift for Health Care Services**

The Commission of Public Hospital District No. 1, Clallam County, Washington (Forks Community Hospital) adopted Resolution No. 2023-579 concerning the district's regular property tax levy. If approved, this proposition would provide additional operating and capital funds for hospital and other health care services including purchasing medical equipment and supporting additional staffing and recruitment. It authorizes a maximum regular property levy rate for collection in 2025 of 75 cents per \$1,000 of assessed value. The 2025 levy amount will be used for the purpose of computing the limitations for levies in subsequent years.

**Crescent School District No. 313
Proposition No. 1
Replacement of Expiring Levy for Educational Programs
and Operations**

The Board of Directors of Crescent School District approved Resolution No. 202307 authorizing an educational programs replacement levy. The proposition would fund student needs not funded by the state including meals, technology for students and staff, other school supplies, athletics and activities, professional development for educators, and transportation and facility maintenance and operations. It would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes to replace an expiring levy on all taxable property within the District:

Proposition No. 2
Capital Projects Levy**

The Board of Directors of Crescent School District adopted Resolution No. 202308 concerning a capital projects levy. The proposition authorizes the construction, modernization, replacement or upgrading of school facilities; renovation and rehabilitation of playfields, athletic fields, and other district real property; the purchase or installation of additional major items of equipment and furniture not including vehicles; major equipment repair; and painting of facilities, and authorizes the following excess levies for such purposes on all taxable property within the District:

Educational Programs and Operations Levy**

The Board of Directors of Cape Flattery School District No. 401 adopted Resolution No. 24-05, concerning a proposition to finance educational programs and operations expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes upon all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund educational programs and operations expenses:
