### County Mails Special Election Ballots

Approximately 7,000 registered voters within Hospital District 1, Crescent School District 313, and Cape Flattery School District 401 will be included in Clallam County's February 13, 2024, Special Election. Active registered voters in the Hospital District and the two School Districts will receive ballots.

Ballots were mailed yesterday, Wednesday, January 24. Election Day is Tuesday, February 13.

Office hours are 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. On Election Day, February 13 we are open until 8:00 p.m.

Your ballot must be postmarked or placed in a Ballot Drop Box by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, February 13, to be counted. If you are using the mail, the USPS recommends voters return their ballot a week before Election Day. Voters returning their ballots less than a week before Election Day are encouraged to use an Official Ballot Drop Box.

There are nine (9) ballot drop boxes throughout the county. Locations can be viewed at [www.votewa.gov/elections](http://www.votewa.gov/elections).

To assist elderly and disable person in voting their ballot, an Accessible Voting Unit (AVU) with large print, color contrast, and audio ballot is available. This unit will be available in the Elections and Voter Registration Office during normal business hours and until 8:00 p.m. on Election Night.
