

How to Vote




Use a **dark colored pen** to completely fill in the oval to the left of your choice.

Write-in Option

To vote for a write-in candidate fill in the oval next to the write-in line and print the name.

How to Correct a Vote



To make a correction, draw a line through the entire incorrect choice. You then have the option of making another choice.

Returning Your Ballot

By Mail: Ballots must be postmarked on or before Election Day to be counted.

By Official Ballot Drop Box: Ballots must be deposited inside an Official Ballot Drop Box by 8:00 p.m. on Election Night to be counted.

- **Voting for more than one candidate will void your ballot.**
