April Special Election Ballots Mailed

CLALLAM COUNTY – The April Special Election is underway! Ballots were mailed on Wednesday, April 3, 2024, to approximately 500 active registered voters within the Clallam County Fire Protection District No. 5. Military and overseas voters' ballots were mailed on March 22, 2024.

Printed Voters' Pamphlets were included in ballots packets mailed to voters. A printable copy is available at www.clallamcountywa.gov/elections. An Online Voters' Guide is also available to you at www.votewa.gov.

Ballots have begun to arrive in mailboxes and will continue to be delivered through next week.

Election Staff opened the Official Ballot Drop Boxes located throughout Clallam County on Wednesday, April 3, 2024, and ballot collection will begin today, Monday, April 8, 2024.

Return your ballot by Official Ballot Drop Box or by mail, no stamp is needed. Your ballot must be deposited in an Official Ballot Drop Box by 8:00 p.m. or postmarked by Election Day, April 23, 2024. If mailed, the USPS recommends that you mail a week before Election Day. Voters returning their ballot less than a week before Election Day are encouraged to use an Official Ballot Drop Box.

There are nine (9) Official Ballot Drop Boxes throughout Clallam County. Locations can be viewed at www.votewa.gov.

To assist the elderly and voters with disabilities in voting their ballot, an Accessible Voting Unit is available in the Elections and Voter Registration Office beginning April 3, 2024, through 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Registered voters in Clallam County Fire Protection District No. 5 who do not receive a ballot packet by the end of next week should call or visit the Elections and Voter Registration Office for a replacement. Voters can also securely access a replacement ballot delivered online by logging into www.votewa.gov.
