**How to Vote**




Use a **dark colored pen** to completely fill in the oval to the left of your choice.

**Vote for ONLY one in each contest.** If you vote for more than one choice, your vote will not count for that race or measure.

**Write-in Option**

To vote for a write-in candidate fill in the oval next to the write-in line and print the name.

**How to Correct a Vote**



To make a correction, draw a line through the entire incorrect choice. You then have the option of making another choice.

**Returning Your Ballot**

**By Mail:** Ballots must be postmarked on or before Election Day to be counted.

**By Official Ballot Drop Box:** Ballots must be deposited inside an Official Ballot Drop Box by 8:00 p.m. on Election Night to be counted.

**Proposition No. 1  
Public Hospital District No. 2  
Levy Lid Lift for Health Care Services**

The Commission of Public Hospital District No. 2, Clallam County, Washington (Olympic Medical Center) adopted Resolution No. 556 concerning the district's regular property tax levy. If approved, this proposition would provide additional operating and capital funds for hospital and other health care services. It authorizes a maximum regular property levy rate for collection in 2025 of 75 cents per \$1,000 of assessed value. The 2025 levy amount will be used for the purpose of computing the limitations for levies in subsequent years. Should this proposition be:

**Proposition No. 1  
Clallam County Fire Protection District No. 2  
Property Tax Levy For Fire Protection and Emergency Medical Services**

The Board of Clallam County Fire Protection District No. 2, adopted Resolution No. 2024-03 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District operations. If approved, this proposition would finance fire protection and emergency medical services by establishing the District's regular property tax levy in 2024 at \$1.50 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation and authorize setting the limit factor at the greater of the statutory 1% limit or the June Seattle-Tacoma-Bellevue CPI-U for the following five years. The maximum allowable levy in the final year shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations as provided by Chapter 84.55 RCW.

Clallam County Fire Protection District No. 2  
Property Tax Levy for Emergency Medical Services**

The Board of Clallam County Fire Protection District No. 2, adopted Resolution No. 2024-05 concerning a proposition to fund emergency medical services.
