Great News! Delayed Voter Pamphlets Are on Their Way

CLALLAM COUNTY UPDATE – On July 17 the Clallam County Elections Office was notified that voter pamphlets had not been delivered to all households in the county due to vendor printing and delivery issues.

This morning, we were notified that the pamphlets arrived earlier than expected and the USPS carriers began delivering them over the weekend. Voters who have not received a Voters' Pamphlet yet, should expect to receive one early this week, if it didn't already show up over the weekend.

During the voting period, the Office of the Secretary of State meets daily with county election officials, USPS representatives and United States Postal Inspection Service (USPIS) representatives to discuss election mail issues and quickly troubleshoot errors.

Our office continues to work with the USPS and our print vendor to create a solution to prevent errors and delays in the future. **No ballot deliveries have been affected by these errors.**
