General Election Random Batch Audit Scheduled

CLALLAM COUNTY – The Clallam County Elections Division will perform a random audit of the General Election at 9:30 AM on November 6, 2024. The testing will take place in the Elections Center located on the lower level of the Clallam County Courthouse, 223 4th St, Room 072, Port Angeles, WA.

This test demonstrates the accuracy of the tabulation equipment. The purpose of the audit is to compare a manual count of ballots to the machine count for randomly selected batches.

The audit is open to the public, with limited in-person observation space available. We will be livestreaming the testing for anyone who would like to observe virtually. To view the livestream, visit the Clallam County Elections website at www.clallamcountywa.gov/elections.

Ballot Return Tip: Clallam County Election always recommends that voters use either the USPS, our official ballot drop boxes, or our Elections and Voter Registration Office to return their ballot. We do not recommend that people utilize unofficial collection and delivery services even though Washington State law does not prohibit them and allows a Washington voter the discretion to determine how to deliver their ballot to the Elections Office.

Some organizations inquire about collection and delivery services. When we become aware of these, we remind the organization (or individual) that they cannot claim to be an official collection/delivery service.
