Availability of Services

CLALLAM COUNTY – Did you know that Clallam County currently has two Accessible Voting Units (AVUs)? The Accessible Voting Units allow voters who may have difficulty using a paper ballot to mark a ballot using a touch screen and/or by responding to audio prompts. Please note that this is a ballot marking device, and not an electronic voting option. During each election, an Accessible Voting Unit is available at the Clallam County Elections and Voter Registration Office, in Room 042 of the Clallam County Courthouse on the lower level. Accessible Voting Units are available Monday through Friday beginning July 16 from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM, and until 8:00 PM on Election Day.

Alternatively, voters can utilize an online ballot to vote. www.VoteWa.gov offers access to an online version of your ballot and declaration that you can fill in, print, sign, and return to our office by Official Ballot Drop Box or postal mail.

If you are unable to cast a ballot due to a disability, you may designate a person of your choice to help you record your votes and prepare your ballot envelope. Remember though, *only you* can make your mark in the signature area of the envelope! If your signature is inconsistent or you are worried it may not match our records, please ask two people to help you by witnessing your mark on the ballot envelope and have them sign in the indicated spaces below your mark.

There are nine Official Ballot Drop Box throughout Clallam County. Locations can be viewed at www.VoteWa.gov on the "Your Ballot and Voting Materials" tab – or call our office at 360-417-2221 to learn more.
