


Resolution 2025 – 1

A Resolution of the Board of the Quillayute Park and Recreation District, Clallam County, Washington, providing for the submission to the qualified electors of the District at an election to be held therein on November 4, 2025, of a proposition to authorize the District to levy a Regular tax of \$.30 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation each year for six years to provide funding for eligible operations of the District. Such levies to be made for six years commencing in 2026 with collection in the years 2026 through 2031.

ADOPTED July 30, 2025

WHEREAS, Quillayute Park and Recreation District, Clallam County, Washington (the "District"), has not had in effect a regular property tax levy to enable the District to pay for its maintenance and operations, and the funds available to the District are insufficient to meet the needs of the District, and;

WHEREAS, Park Districts are authorized regular tax levies by a vote of the resident electors of the District, and;

WHEREAS, the District has been wise stewards of public funds originally levied to construct the facility, and has been operating and maintaining the facilities primarily using timber dollars held in reserve, which are no longer being accrued as the construction levy has ceased to collect, and;

WHEREAS, every year the District's balance dwindles, and the necessary funds to continue operations are not available through any other known source, and;

WHEREAS, to properly provide for eligible expenditures, the Board of Directors of the District deems it necessary to levy a tax upon all of the taxable property within the District, such levy to be made commencing in 2026 for collection in the years from 2026 through 2031, inclusive, as authorized by RCW 36.69.145, and;

WHEREAS, the Constitution and laws of the State of Washington require that the question of whether or not such taxes may be levied must be submitted to the qualified electors of the District for their ratification or rejection;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF QUILLAYUTE PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT, CLALLAM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Taxes for the District should be levied upon all the taxable property within the District at a rate of \$.30 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation each year for six years to provide funding for eligible operations of the District, such levies to be made for six years commencing in 2026 with collection in the years 2026 through 2031.

Section 2. Authorization of use of Funds: The District shall apply levy proceeds for the maintenance and operations of District assets, including a swimming pool and related properties and facilities and appurtenances, as well as other recreation facilities and activities as determined by the Board.

Section 3. It is hereby found and declared that the best interests of the District require the submission to the qualified electors of the District of the proposition whether the District shall levy such tax for their ratification or rejection at an election to be held on November 4, 2025.

The Clallam County Auditor, as ex officio supervisor of elections in Clallam County, is hereby requested to call and conduct such election to be held by an all mail-in ballot within the District on said date and to submit to the qualified electors of the District the proposition substantially in the form hereinafter set forth.

The Secretary of the Board of Directors is hereby authorized and directed to certify said proposition in substantially the following form:

6-YEAR REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY

The Board of Directors of Quillayute Park and Recreation District approved Resolution 2025 – 1 authorizing a Regular property tax levy equal to \$.30 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation, for six years commencing in 2026 for collection in the years 2026 through 2031. The proposition would fund District needs including maintenance and operations of District assets.

The Secretary of the Board of Directors is hereby directed to deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the Clallam County Auditor.


Section 3. Pursuant to authority granted by RCW 29A.32.220, the Board hereby authorizes the District’s participation in the local voters’ pamphlet for the November 4, 2025 election and requests that the Clallam County Auditor prepare and publish a voter’s pamphlet for this proposition. The District understands and agrees that it will be required to pay its proportionate share of the expenses of the voters’ pamphlet.

Section 4. For purposes of receiving notice of the exact language of the ballot title required by RCW 29A.36.080, the Board hereby designates Director Donald Grafstrom as the individual to whom the Auditor shall provide such notice. Director Grafstrom is

authorized to approve changes to the ballot title, if any, deemed necessary by the Auditor or the Clallam County Prosecuting Attorney.

Explanatory Statement

The Quillayute Park and Recreation District (the “District”) serves the greater Forks area and owns a facility that the Forks Athletic & Aquatic Club operates out of as a public/private partnership. In 2000, voters approved general obligation bonds to construct this facility but rejected a levy to support the maintenance and operations of the District. As a result, the facility was closed for several years until the public/private partnership was created. Future operations of the facility are threatened by lack of revenue to support ongoing maintenance of the facility. Based on the current assessed value of property within the district, the proposed \$.30 per \$1,000 of assessed value would result in an estimated levy amount payable by an owner of a home with an assessed value of \$300,000 of \$7.50 per month or \$90 per year.

If Proposition 1 passes, the District will have sufficient revenues to support the operations and maintenance of the facility.

If Proposition 1 fails, the District will likely be forced to defer required maintenance and eventually close the facility in the coming years.
