**AMENDMENT B  
TO  
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT #100811-10-01  
BETWEEN  
THE CLALLAM COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE  
AND  
THE JAMESTOWN S'KLALLAM TRIBE**

1. This amendment seeks to sustain 2 trained law enforcement deputy to assist in the enforcement of tribal law on Jamestown S'Klallam Tribal Lands.
2. The Sheriff of Clallam County agrees to provide 2 law enforcement deputies that will generally be assigned to the eastern areas of Clallam County. This allows for a greater law enforcement presence in the Jamestown S'Klallam community in the Blyn area.
3. The Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe agrees the Sheriff retains full ability to assign all deputies to calls for backup of other deputies or officers, and routine calls outside the eastern county areas during staffing shortages and other emergencies.
4. Compensation from Jamestown S'Klallam Tribal council for the 2 deputies is as follows:
