STATE MEASURES

Proposed by Initiative Petition

INITIATIVE MEASURE 960

Initiative Measure No. 960 concerns tax and fee increases imposed by state government.

This measure would require two-thirds legislative approval or voter approval for tax increases, legislative approval of fee increases, certain published information on tax-increasing bills, and advisory votes on taxes enacted without voter approval.

REFERENDUM MEASURE 67

The legislature passed Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 5726 (ESSB 5726) concerning insurance fair conduct related to claims for coverage or benefits and voters have filed a sufficient referendum petition on this bill.

This bill would make it unlawful for insurers to unreasonably deny certain coverage claims, and permit treble damages plus attorney fees for that and other violations. Some health insurance carriers would be exempt.

ENGROSSED SUBSTITUTE SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 8206

The legislature has proposed a constitutional amendment on establishment of a budget stabilization account.

This amendment would require the legislature to transfer 1% of general state revenues to a budget stabilization account each year and prohibit expenditures from the account except as set forth in the amendment.

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 8212

The legislature has proposed a constitutional amendment on inmate labor.

ENGROSSED HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 4204

The legislature has proposed a constitutional amendment on school district tax levies.

CLALLAM COUNTY HOME RULE CHARTER AMENDMENTS

**Amendment No. 1
 Instant Run-Off Voting**

The Clallam County Charter Review Commission has proposed amending the Clallam County Home Rule Charter concerning instant runoff or rank choice voting for candidates for elected County offices except judges and the Prosecuting Attorney. This amendment would authorize the County Commissioners to adopt an ordinance that would allow for instant runoff or rank choice voting to be used in place of the current method of voting. **Amendment No. 2
 Eminent Domain**

The Clallam County Charter Review Commission has proposed amending the Clallam County Home Rule Charter concerning eminent domain. This amendment would require that private property taken by the County would only be for public use and not primarily or substantially for economic development purposes. It would further require that any interest taken by the County be limited only to that which is necessary to accomplish the public use. Should this proposal be:

Director of the County Department of Community Development

The Clallam County Charter Review Commission has proposed amending the Clallam County Home Rule Charter concerning changing the manner of selecting a specific County officer. This amendment would change the manner of selecting the Director of the County Department of Community Development from direct election by the voters to appointment by the County Commissioners. Frequency of Charter Review

This amendment would require the County Commissioners to cause an election of a Charter Review Commission commencing with the state-wide general election in November 2014 and every eight (8) years thereafter. QUILLAYUTE VALLEY METROPOLITAN PARK DISTRICT

Proposition No. 1

Formation and Funding of a New Metropolitan Park District

The Clallam County Board of Commissioners through Resolution No. 59, 2007 and the Forks City Council through Resolution No. 357, 2007 have jointly proposed creating the Quillayute Valley Metropolitan Park District, which District would have boundaries identical to those of the existing Quillayute Valley Park and Recreation District. If approved, this proposition would create a metropolitan park district with all the powers provided in chapter 35.61 RCW including, but not limited to, the authority to levy a general tax on all property located in the District each year not to exceed seventy-five cents per thousand dollars of assessed valuation. The District would be governed by a five-member board of commissioners to be elected at large.
