Clallam County is soliciting proposals from interested parties to provide design, engineering, community outreach, and potentially services during construction to the Board of Clallam County Commissioners, to realign a portion of the Lower Dungeness River Army Corps levee and restore the associated floodplain on the right bank of the Dungeness River between river mile 0.8 and river mile 1.8, 5 miles north of the City of Sequim, Washington.
