Clallam County will host an open house for the lower Dungeness River floodplain restoration project. At the open house project staff will introduce the community to the restoration project, show the alignment of Towne Road in the project area, and gather input on trails that may be built once the floodplain is restored.

The open house will be held on Tuesday, November 29, from 6-8 pm at the Dungeness Schoolhouse, 2781 Towne Road, Sequim.

Located between the Dungeness Schoolhouse and the Dungeness Valley Creamery, the lower Dungeness River floodplain restoration project seeks to reconnect the river with about 110 acres its floodplain. Partners in the project include landowners, state, federal, and local agencies, and the Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe. Restoring the lower Dungeness River has been a priority of the Dungeness River Management Team since the late 1990's.
