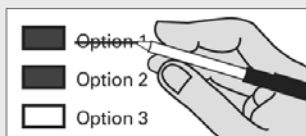

SEQUIM SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 323

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENTS

GENERAL OBLIGATIONS BONDS - \$154,325,000

The Board of Sequim School District No. 323 adopted Resolution No. 03-2013-2014 concerning capital improvements to District facilities. This proposition authorizes the District to renovate Greywolf Elementary School, upgrade and repurpose the Haller Elementary building, construct a new elementary school, renovate and expand Sequim High School, replace athletic facilities, and make other capital improvements, and authorizes the District to issue \$154,325,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 20 years and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, as provided in Resolution No. 03-2013-2014. CAPE FLATTERY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 401

MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION LEVY

The Board of Directors of Cape Flattery School District No. 401 adopted Resolution No. 14-04, concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes upon all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund educational maintenance and operation expenses:
