
How to vote

Proposition No. 1

Sales and Use Tax for Transportation Improvements

The Governing Board of the Port Angeles Transportation Benefit District adopted Resolution TBD 01-17, concerning a sales and use tax to fund transportation improvements. This proposition would authorize a sales and use tax of two-tenths of one percent (0.2%) to be collected from all taxable retail sales within the District in accordance with RCW 82.14.0455 for a term of ten (10) years for the purpose of paying for or financing the cost of the following transportation improvement projects: street and sidewalk preservation, maintenance, and repair, including transportation improvement projects identified in the City's Six-Year (2017-2022) Transportation Improvement Plan.
