Clallam County
Fire Protection District No. 2
Single-Year Levy Lid Lift**

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Clallam County Fire Protection District No. 2 adopted Resolution No. 2020-03 concerning a proposition to finance maintenance, operations and facilities improvements. The proposition shall authorize the District to set the District's regular property tax rate at \$1.36 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation, exceeding the 1% limitation on annual increases in tax revenues for one year, with the levy dollar amount collected in 2021 to be used for computing the limitation for subsequent levies.
