

How should I prepare and transport my HHW to the Moderate Risk Waste Facility?

Proper handling and transportation of hazardous waste can reduce the chance of accidental spills.

For your safety and the safety of the hazardous waste staff, please:

- Don't mix products
- Keep products in original containers
- Label products not in original containers
- Secure products so they won't tip over and/or leak
- Secure the entire load in your vehicle or trailer
- Store products away from the passenger compartment of your vehicle and keep them separate from items you wish to keep
- **Stay in your vehicle during unloading**

MRWF is open:

Saturdays Only

Hours of Operation: 11am-4pm

HHW, such as pesticides, fertilizer, thinners, solvents, cleaning supplies, old gasoline, used oil, hobby chemicals, and anti-freeze, can be taken to the MRWF Facility.

The MRWF **does not** accept paint or paint-related products, fluorescent tubes, pharmaceuticals or Business Waste at this time.

Costs of this program are paid through a Department of Ecology grant and Regional Transfer Station disposal fees.

What are my HHW disposal options in Clallam County?

HHW are products that can cause harm to humans, pets, and the environment, including household cleaners, solvents, oil, gasoline, and lawn and garden supplies like fertilizers and pesticides.



HHW can be taken to the **Moderate Risk Waste Facility (MRWF)** located in Port Angeles at the Regional Transfer Station at 3501 West 18th Street.

There is no charge to homeowners for this service!

The facility does not accept business waste, paint or paint-related products, fluorescent tubes, electronic or pharmaceutical waste at this time.

Auto batteries, oil and antifreeze can be taken to any transfer station during operating hours.



REUSE AREA

There is a FREE reuse area at the MRWF. HHW that is in good condition and can be reused is placed at the MRWF.

Browse the reuse area

and take home fertilizers, paints, thinners, stains, and other chemicals in good condition from previous customers.



ELECTRONIC WASTE

Old computers, monitors, and televisions can be recycled for FREE at Goodwill in Port Angeles or Sequim. For more information go to www.ecyclewashington.org.

MERCURY LIGHTS/TUBES

There is a recycle system for fluorescent tubes and compact fluorescent bulb disposal at no cost, similar to electronic waste disposal. Current sites include Thurman Supply, Swain's, and Around Again in Sequim. For more information, go to www.lightrecycle.org.



PAINT & PAINT-RELATED ITEMS

Paint can be dropped off for free at Around Again, Hartnagel Building Supply, Rodda Paint, and Sherwin-Williams.

PHARMACEUTICAL WASTE



Pharmaceutical waste is not accepted at the MRWF. Pharmaceutical wastes can be disposed of free of charge at the following kiosk locations:
