





Q3 Age of the advocate you support:





Q5 To which gender does the advocate you support most identify?







Q9 What is the current employment status of the advocate you support?









Q13 Respite services are available for the advocate I support









Q17 I feel that the advocate I support has the skills necessary to stay safe when accessing their community through public transportation:















Q26 When I am out and about, I see people with disabilities working in my community:











Q31 The advocate I support knows how to find out about activities, groups or events in their community:


