



PROPOSED BLUFF TRAIL REALIGNMENT PLAN




CONTEXT PLAN



BLUFF TRAIL REALIGNMENT

The existing Bluff Trail has eroded in several places and is expected to continue to erode. To preserve views across the Strait of Juan De Fuca a new alignment is proposed pulling the trail, viewpoints and picnic sites back closer to the camp loops as shown on the drawing. Signage along the trails will inform visitors of the dangers of continued erosion along the bluff.


PARK ENTRANCE


Signage will indicate that there are separate fees for access to the wildlife refuge and will be collected at the entrance to the refuge.

CONTEXT PLAN




Figure 1. Campsite Vignettes

CAMPING (Figure 1)

- Two campground loops retained, with one loop retained for tent/car camping and the other converted to RV sites – number of campsites maximized.
- 4-12 Cabin campsites with adjacent parking.
- Bicycle camping area expanded with appropriate services.
- Group camping and picnic area improved with power, water and possibly other services.
- Implement a reservation system.



PROPOSED CAMP LOOP C - PREFERRED OPTION
