## CAMP HOST POSITION DESCRIPTION

<b>Worksite:</b>	County Recreation Areas
<b>Position Goal:</b>	To provide a positive, helpful, and informative presence in our campgrounds and recreation areas, while providing additional on-site security.
<b>Sample Activities:</b>	<p>Provide campground and recreation area information and rules to campers and visitors. Answer visitors' questions and provide information about local services and attractions. Help campers and visitors contact emergency assistance as needed.</p> <p>Patrol campground and recreational areas on a regular basis to assess and report on the status of public lands. Open and close recreational site gates as scheduled.</p> <p>Regularly inspect park restrooms, picnic shelters, campsites, campfire pits and boat launch areas to ensure they are safe and clean for public use. Immediately secure vandalized and unsafe facilities until they are repaired. Perform maintenance and sanitation tasks with the approval and under the direction of the on-site Park Manager. These tasks may include cleaning campfire pits, assist with the firewood sales, picking up litter, cleaning and/or stocking restrooms, raking campsites, sweeping stairways/sidewalks, and other similar park chores.</p> <p>Report vandalism and illegal or abusive behavior immediately to park staff and/or local law enforcement agency.</p>
<b>Timeframe:</b>	Length of commitment: Minimum of one month Schedule: Arranged by Park Manager
<b>Minimum Qualifications:</b>	Ability to perform duties in a friendly and professional manner Communication skills to deal effectively with confrontational situations Ability to provide a clean, attractive motor home, camper, or travel trailer Willingness to work cooperatively and under direction of the Parks staff Valid State Driver's License and proof of insurance on private vehicle
<b>Desired Qualifications:</b>	Skilled in oral communications and/or handyperson skills Training in First Aid and CPR
<b>Reports To:</b>	Park Manager
<b>Benefits:</b>	Park Host site with water, electricity, septic while volunteering Opportunity to represent the community to area visitors Letter of reference for future positions Medical only industrial insurance benefits for injury or occupational disease incurred in performing authorized duties Liability coverage for volunteers acting within the scope of their official duties
