



About the Map

Shoreline Environmental Designations provide a framework for SMP policies and regulations based on their characteristics. The SMP applies to streams (or segments thereof) with a mean annual flow of 20 cfs, lakes greater than 20 acres, and marine waters; together with their underlying lands and associated shorelands. The mapped jurisdictional extent is based on the approximate location of areas within 200 feet of the ordinary high water mark (OHWM) and floodway, 100-year floodplain, and associated wetlands. The full jurisdictional extent also includes critical areas and their protective buffers overlapping shorelands. The County SMP does not apply within the Olympic National Park, cities, or lands held in trust by the U.S. for Indian Tribes. The actual physical location of SMP jurisdiction requires professional judgment and site specific information.
